Call Number: where material can be found in Library/alphanumeric label on item

General Stacks: A – G on main floor of Library; H – Z on second floor of Library

[eBrary/eBooks](#)– collection of electronic books available through library website

Searchable in Augusta Technical College Online Library Catalog and webpage

Remote access requires Student ID number

[GALILEO](#) – Georgia Library Learning Online

Databases: full text articles to print, save, or email:

- Britannica = Encyclopedia
- EBSCO & ProQuest = journal articles; MEDLINEplus = medical information
- Novelist = fiction; WorldCat = fiction/nonfiction

Password: needed off campus/found on SmartWeb or at Library

Citation: Author, Title of Article, Journal Name, Date, Page, Volume...

[Internet](#) – vast amount of information found through search engines

UR: address of information site

Common types: com = commercial; edu=education; org=organization, gov=government; net = net

[GCIS](#) – Georgia Career Information Center

Password: always needed/found on [SmartWeb](#) or at Library

Occupations: comprehensive information including salary range/job prospects
