Disqualifiers for Academic Ranking
Students are NOT eligible for academic ranking if:

1. The grade point average (GPA) in the prerequisite courses is less than 2.75 .
2. Natural science pre-requisite courses are older than 5 years ( 60 months).
3. Any of the following are submitted after the designated deadline:

- College Admission Application
- Competitive Ranking Application

4. An informational session has not been attended during the Spring semester prior to Fall ranking.

Academic Ranking Criteria
Students will be ranked by a weighted score to be calculated using the following criteria:
