RETURN TO CAMPUS PLAN

OBJECTIVES

- Protect the health and safety of the campus community.
- Resume on-campus instructional, student support and administrative services.
- Provide appropriate resumption of additional on-campus activities.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

- **Integrity**: Fully adhere to Federal, State and County guidance
- **Collaboration**: Institution and department plans and timelines must be flexible.
- Responsiveness: Transitions between steps must be coordinated and will be dependent upon access to protective supplies and materials.
- **Leadership**: Clear communication to students, faculty, staff and community is essential.
- **Teamwork:** We are all in this together! If you are running a fever or experiencing symptoms, protect others by staying home and getting the care you need.

PHASED REOPENING STEPS

Employees and Students



Current

Begin transitioning employees back to campus based on function as determined by supervisor. Continue limited lab opportunities for students to complete Summer semester instruction. Provide limited services on campus.



August 3, 2020

Continue to transition employees back to campus. Continue limited lab opportunities or students to complete Summer semester instruction. Provide additional limited services on campus.



August 24, 2020

Fall Semester begins with full operation hours on campuses. Campus access will require observance of protective protocols in and out of class, as well as limitations or restrictions for identified areas, services or operations. All students and employees must wear college issued face masks.

Additional employees will return to campus to provide essential tasks and limited services.

All Employees will return to campus for operating hours and may also be teleworking.

Employee work hours will be determined by supervisor. If you have concerns or need guidance, contact HR to discuss your individual circumstances.

STUDENT PHASED APPROACH

Students begin returning to campus for limited services while minimizing walk-in traffic.

Only students participating in limited lab activities as scheduled and directed by their instructor or college administration are allowed in classroom/lab spaces.
