Currently, there have not been any cases of coronavirus exposure to anyone on our campuses. We continue to provide our college community with communications that detail preventative measures people should take to reduce risk of infection. This includes CDC-recommended strategies such like:

- Washing hands regularly
- Avoiding the touching of eyes, nose, and mouth
- Covering coughs and sneezes with tissues
- Avoiding close contact with those who may be sick
- Staying home when sick

We are following guidance from The Governor's office, the Center for Disease Control, and the Department of Public Health. We are also taking extra measures to regularly clean and disinfect areas that have high amounts of human contact. This includes lavatories, doorknobs, elevators, and stair railings, among other items. We are monitoring this developing situation closely and we are committed to providing you with accurate information in a timely manner.
