<p>By the designated deadline:</p> <p>Complete the following prerequisite Courses with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.</p> <p>PREREQUISITE COURSES</p> <p>ALHS 1011 – Structure and Function of the Human Body</p> <p>ALHS 1040 – Introduction to Healthcare</p> <p>COMP 1000 – Introduction to Computer Literacy</p> <p>ENGL 1010 – Fundamentals of English</p> <p>MATH 1012 – Foundations of Mathematics</p> <p>PSYC 1010 – Basic Psychology</p>	<p>Students are NOT eligible for academic ranking if:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A grade of less than a “C” is received in two or more prerequisite courses. (NOTE: This includes less than a “C” in the same or a different course taken at Augusta Technical College and courses included on official transcripts for any previous colleges/universities attended.)* 2. The grade point average (GPA) in the prerequisite courses is less than 2.5. 3. Pre-requisite courses with the ALHS prefix are older than 5 years (60 months). 4. Any of the following are submitted after the designated deadline: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • College Admission Application • Competitive Ranking Application 	<p>Students will be ranked by a weighted score to be calculated using the following criteria:</p> <p>The Grade Point Average (GPA) in the prerequisite courses listed below represents one hundred percent (100%) of the ranking score.</p> <p>ALHS 1011 – Structure and Function of the Human Body</p> <p>ALHS 1040 – Introduction to Healthcare</p> <p>ENGL 1010 – Fundamentals of English</p> <p>PSYC 1010 – Basic Psychology</p>

***NOTES:**

1. **Forgiveness Rule:** Unsuccessful course attempts that led to ineligibility for academic ranking will expire after five years (60 months). This applies to any courses that led to ineligibility.
2. **Ranking Courses:** Students must receive a grade of “C” or less to retake prerequisite course. This policy also applies to students with a transfer grade of “C”. The highest grade will be used for ranking purposes.
