- **1. Forgiveness Rule:** Unsuccessful course attempts that led to ineligibility for academic ranking will expire after five years (60 months). This applies to <u>any</u> courses that led to ineligibility.
- **2.** TEAS scores are good for five years (60 months). **Effective August 31, 2016,** a new version of the TEAS test became effective. If a student has tested within the past 5 years (60 months), his or her scores <u>ARE</u> still valid.
- 3. Retaking Courses or TEAS Test:
 - **a.** Students must receive a grade of "C" or less to retake a prerequisite course. **Each attempt will calculate in the overall ranking GPA.** This policy also applies to students with a transfer grade of a "C".
 - b. Two TEAS scores may be submitted per ranking cycle with a 30-day waiting period between attempts and the highest score will be used for ranking purposes.
