

**The Test of Essential Academic Skills (ATI TEAS)** is a multiple choice assessment that measures basic academic preparedness in Reading, Math, Science, English and Language Usage.

Candidates for Diagnostic Medical Sonography, Associate Degree Nursing, and Practical Nursing are required to take the ATI TEAS Exam before the published application deadline.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE ATI TEAS:**

- The ATI TEAS Exam is offered on the Augusta, Thomson, & Waynesboro campuses by appointment only.
- The cost of the ATI TEAS exam is **\$77.00**.
- Registration:
  1. To get started, register for the ATI TEAS Exam online at [www.atitesting.com](http://www.atitesting.com) .
  2. First-time users must create an account.
  3. After successfully logging in, click *Online Store*.
  4. Select *Register for TEAS*.
  5. Program Type:
    - **TEAS for Nursing** –For Associate Degree Nursing (ADN) or Practical Nursing Applicants (LPN)
    - **TEAS for Allied Health**–For Diagnostic Medical Sonography (DMS) Applicants.
  6. Continue by selecting your Country, State, and City for Testing Centers near you.
  7. Select the desired date/location and check out to reserve your seat.
- Applicants must wait **30 days** to retest after each attempt.
- Applicants may submit a maximum of **two** TEAS scores per ranking cycle. The highest ATI TEAS Exam score will be used for ranking purposes.
- Students who test at other institutions must have an official score report sent from ATI to Augusta Tech. ***Please note a minimum TEAS score of 58.7% must be on file prior to submitting a Competitive Ranking Application.***
  - To request an ATI TEAS transcript visit [www.atitesting.com](http://www.atitesting.com). Log into your ATI account, select *My Results* tab, select *Share Results* link, select **Augusta Technical College** as your institution, click continue to open the Shopping Cart, and then click *Check Out* to open the secure checkout page. ATI TEAS Exam transcripts cost **\$27.00**.
