A grade of less than a “C” is received in two or more prerequisite courses. (NOTE: This includes less than a “C” in the same or a different course taken at Augusta Technical College and courses included on official transcripts for any previous colleges/universities attended.)* 2. The grade point average (GPA) in the prerequisite courses is less than 2.75. 3. Natural science pre-requisite courses are <u>older</u> than 5 years (60 months). 4. Pre-requisite courses with the ALHS prefix are <u>older</u> than 5 years (60 months). 5.
