***IMPORTANT NOTES:**

- **Retaking Courses:** Students can retake a course; the highest grade will be used for ranking purposes.
- **Information Sessions:** Students will be **REQUIRED** to attend an information session within **1 year** of submitting their application. Requirements can be found within each Competitive Degree Work track sheet.
- **The ATI TEAS exam is required for ranking, with a composite score of 67% needed within two years of submitting the ranking application. (ATI TEAS Exam scores expire for ATC Ranking after two years.)**
- **A grade of 'C' or higher is required for all courses.**
- ***Students who have successfully completed 15 semester hours of transfer credit or have previously earned a college credential are exempt from taking COLL 1060**
