THE SURVEY QUESTIONS


In the survey we asked seven questions to get a broad idea about how people feel about art, technological advances, and societies. These included:

- Do you think that advances in art have helped us reach across to diverse communities?




AGE STATISTICS

Question: What is your age?



GENDER STATISTICS


Question: What is your gender?







Question: Do you believe the internet and advances in technologies have broadened the boundaries of art?




POSITIVE OR NEGATIVE STATISTICS
