POLICY:

Colleges accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) must require that all documents submitted to the Commission are candid and provide all relevant information. In addition, each College will provide SACSCOC access to its operations and complete and accurate information about the College's affairs, including reports of other accrediting, licensing, and auditing agencies.

Each College must develop and maintain a written procedure that requires all information submitted to the Commission to be timely, complete, accurate, and current to ensure that the College operates with integrity in all matters.
