College Campuses

POLICY:

The State Board must authorize the establishment of any campus of a Technical College.

The Technical College shall administer any campus within whose service area is located or designated by the State Board. An institution's main campus is the street address used for the institution as a whole. The main campus is typically the campus where the central administrative offices are located. Course/program offerings may include technical certificate/diploma/degree courses, adult education, business/ industry services, and continuing education. An off-campus instructional site (OCIS) is a teaching site located geographically apart from the main campus. These sites do not require State Board approval.

All programs and courses offered at a campus shall be operated and adequately supervised by an on-site administrator or an administrator from another campus and subject to the same standards and requirements in such areas as curriculum, personnel, facilities, evaluation, budgeting, record keeping, and accreditation as would be required if operated at the central campus.

The Commissioner shall develop appropriate procedures for the implementation of this policy.
