

Poster/Photo Contest Guidelines & Rules:

Each semester, the Distance Education department runs a poster or photography contest. Themes change each semester. Details are published in the Distance Ed newsletter each semester which is posted on table top displays in the library, café, and student lounges.

Eligibility:

The contest is open to current students and employees of Augusta Technical College

Agreement to Rules:

Winners are chosen at the sole discretion of Augusta Technical College staff and its selected judges.

How to Enter:

All required elements within the entry form must be completed to be eligible for a prize. All entries must be submitted through the online entry form or email address.

Only entries received during the posted time periods are eligible for prizes.

Contestants may submit up to 4 entries, but each submission requires a separate entry form.

Your Work Must Be Original:

You must be the creator of the artwork entered into the competition. Any adaption of someone else's work must fall under appropriate fair use copyright law.

Your work must not violate anyone else's copyright and all violations will be disqualified.

Entry Fee:

There is no cost to enter.

Prize:

The top 5 winners will each receive a \$25 gift card to the campus store.

No cash or other prize substitution is permitted. The prize is nontransferable. Any and all prize-related expenses are the sole responsibility of the winner. The winner will be notified within 14 days of the contest end. Prizes must be claimed within 30 days of the winner being notified or the prize is voided.

Prizes must be claimed in person at Augusta Tech College during regular business hours.

Copyright:

You retain all copyrights to your artwork, without exception.

Non-exclusive permission: Your entry into any of the contests grants Augusta Tech College a non-exclusive perpetual license to reproduce your artwork in our social media, on our website, in our newsletter and catalogs, and in marketing material for future contests.

Modifications may be made to the work for size adjustments or additional wording as needed.

Privacy Policy: Information submitted with an entry is subject to the Privacy Policy of Augusta Tech College.

Augusta Tech College may contact you from time to time, but will never sell your personal contact information.

- Poster Size is 18 x 24, 300 DPI resolution. (This is an optimum size. Entrees not meeting poster size will still be considered)
- PDF or JPEG file formats preferred.
