Ms. Serrano was chosen by a panel of local leaders over three other nominees for the award. The runners-up were Angela Cammarano-Moses, Villa Rica, Occupational Therapy Assistant, Afaf Elbawab, Augusta, Medical Assisting, and Kaylei Martin, Martinez, Business Healthcare Technology. GOAL, a statewide program of the Technical College System of Georgia, honors excellence in academics and leadership among the state's technical college students. Local GOAL winners are selected at each of the state's 22 technical colleges.

Ms. Serrano will represent Augusta Technical College at the regional competition on April 22, 2021. The nine regional finalists, three finalists from the three regions, will be announced in May 2021 and if selected, Ms. Serrano will participate in state competition in May 2021. A panel of leaders from the business, industry and government sectors will interview them and choose one to be the 2021 State GOAL Winner, TCSG's Student of the Year, and the recipient of the GOAL medallion. The grand prize also includes a brand-new car, courtesy of KIA, the statewide corporate sponsor of the GOAL program.
