VERIFICATION OF LAWFUL PRESENCE & PROOF OF GEORGIA RESIDENCY

As you apply for admission or re-admission at Augusta Technical College, please be aware: **all applicants** seeking **classification as in-state for tuition purposes** are required to provide **proof of lawful presence in the United States** <u>and</u> **legal proof of residency in the State of Georgia**, in accordance with Georgia HB 87 and Technical College System of Georgia policy.

Does this Requirement Apply to Me?

Yes. This requirement applies to *any student* who wishes to enroll and to be considered for in-state tuition. To be considered for in-state tuition, a student must be a legal resident of Georgia for 12 consecutive months prior to the first day of the enrollment term. The student must provide proof of lawful presence in the United States *and* proof of Georgia residency.

How Do I Prove Legal Presence in the U.S.?

The following is a partial list of documents that serves as <u>proof of lawful presence</u> in the United States. Further documentation may be required before you are eligible for in-state tuition:

- A current Driver's License or ID issued by the State of Georgia after January 1, 2008.
- A current Driver's License or ID issued by a state that verifies immigration status and only issues to persons lawfully present in the United States. The Technical College System of Georgia (TCSG) will accept the following:
 - o **Alabama:** Issued after August 1, 2000
 - o Florida: Issued after January 1, 2010 AND have a gold star in the upper right hand corner
 - o **South Carolina:** Issued after November 1, 2008
 - o Tennessee: Issued after May 29, 2004
- A certified U.S. Birth Certificate showing the student was born in the U.S. or a U.S. territory. A photocopy is not acceptable.
- An approved completed FAFSA for the current financial aid year.
- A current, valid Permanent Resident Card (USCIS form 1-151 or 1-551).
- A current, valid military identification card for active duty soldiers or veterans.
- A U.S. Certificate of Birth Abroad issued by the Department of State (DS-1350) or a Consular Report of Birth Abroad (FS-240)..
- A current U.S. passport.
- A U.S. Certificate of Citizenship (USCIS form N-560 or N-561).
- A U.S. Certificate of Naturalization (USCIS form N-550 or N-570).

Any student who cannot be verified as lawfully present in the United States is not eligible to be considered for in-state tuition, regardless of how long he or she has lived in Georgia. In addition to being lawfully present in the United States, students must meet the in-state tuition requirements as outlined in TCSG Board Policy and Procedures V.B.3 to be classified as in-state. Students that are initially classified as out-of-state, and successfully petition to have their residency changed to in-state also have to meet the verification requirement.

How Do I Prove Georgia Residency?

Some documents above (such as a Georgia Driver's license or state ID card issued at least 12 months prior to enrollment) prove legal presence in the U.S. and Georgia residency. In other cases, additional documentation may be required to prove Georgia residency, such as:

- Copy of lease agreement or utility bill (gas, electric, water) showing you have resided at a Georgia address for 12 months (Note: Cell phone bills are not acceptable documentation);
- Georgia income tax return from previous year (from student if independent, from parent(s) if dependent);
- Georgia voter registration card showing registration 12 months prior to enrollment;
- Georgia automobile registration (12 month requirement);
- Notarized letter on company letterhead indicating lease status (12 month requirement);
- **Proof of ownership of primary residence in Georgia** (12 month requirement).

What Do I Need to Do?

If you have one of the items listed above (**except your birth certificate**), please provide it to the College at least 30 days in advance of your registration date. You may:

- Mail a copy with your application (See mailing address on page 2 of application),
- Present it in person to the Admissions Office (1300 Building or at your Augusta Tech location),
- Fax a copy to the Admissions Office to 706-771-4034, or
- Scan it, and if readable, send it as an attachment to admission@augustatech.edu.
- **Please note:** We cannot accept copies of the U.S. birth certificate; instead, original certified U.S. birth certificates must be mailed or presented directly to the Admissions Office.

What If I Do Not Have Documents Listed Above?

Applicants who do not present proof of lawful presence in the United States will be charged at the foreign student tuition rate, which is four times the in-state tuition rate. Applicants who are not United States citizens and not permanent residents and seek to petition for out-of-state tuition consideration must provide one or more of the following to the Director of Admissions for consideration:

- Residency petition form (available in Admissions Office);
- A current copy of your visa and I-94;
- If you have a current Employment Authorization Card please include a copy of it with your documents.

What If I Live in a Border County Eligible for Reciprocity of Georgia Tuition?

Legal residents in a bordering South Carolina county eligible for in-state tuition, including legal residents of Aiken, Allendale, Barnwell, Edgefield, and McCormick Counties, must provide proof of residency in those counties, such as a SC state-issued ID or driver's license.

What If I'm Active Military (Service member, Spouse, or Dependent)?

If you are an active military service member/spouse/dependent, seeking in-state tuition, you may present your military ID and a copy of military orders showing that you are stationed in Georgia, or provide documentation that your home of record is Georgia. Spouses/dependents may present their spouse/dependent ID and copy of spouse/parent orders.

What If I Move?

All applicants and students are responsible for submitting updated address information to the Office of Student Records by completing and turning in a change of address form, available at http://www.augustatech.edu/student records.html.
