Kaplan University Transfer Articulation Information

Augusta Technical College (ATC) and Kaplan University (KU) have a transfer articulation agreement to support students transferring into KU following completion of a certificate, diploma, or associate degree program at ATC. Students having completed an associate's degree program consisting of a minimum of 90 quarter credits or 60 semester credits will be eligible for a block transfer of up to 90-quarter credits and acceptance into KU's "advanced start" baccalaureate option. ATC students must fulfill KU requirements, which entail completion of no less than 25 percent of their program requirements at KU, including a minimum of 50 percent of the major requirements, including the capstone course, at KU. Credit earned through any combination of Transfer Credit, Challenge Credit or Experiential Credit will not exceed 76 percent of total credits required for graduation.
