Toolbox Scholarship	This scholarship is awarded each term based on financial need and range up to \$250 per term. There is a limit of one Toolbox per year per recipient. The scholarship is to be used for books, tools and supplies listed on program supply list.				
The Lisa Nagle Medical Assisting Scholarship	Students must be enrolled in the Medical Assisting program full time and have a grade point average of 3.0 or better. Academic transcript required. Letter in your own words explaining the reasons for your interest in the field of Medical Assisting and the reason you need financial assistance. A letter of reference from a professional in field (CMA, office manager, physician). Funds may be used for tuition, fees, books, supplies and/or uniforms. In the event you receive an award in your last term, funds may be used for expenses outside the college environment as many students have had to terminate their jobs to finish program requirements.				
The Barbara Williams Dental Assisting Scholarship	This scholarship is awarded annually to a student pursuing a dental diploma in their "second semester" of Dental Assisting classes. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and have a 3.0 cumulative grade point average. This is a one-time annual award up to \$500.				
The J. D. Smith Waynesboro Rotary Club Scholarship	This is \$750 scholarship is awarded annually to a Burke County resident pursuing an Associate Degree. The recipient must have a grade point average of 2.0 or better, must have demonstrated financial need, must not be receiving HOPE or Pell, and must not be enrolled in learning support classes. Preference is given to students who have been members of Interact in high school.				
Todd R. Cato Memorial Scholarship	Established in memory of former student, Todd R. Cato. One scholarship is awarded annually to an area high school graduate, was active in an extracurricular activity and has an overall grade average of 75 or better. This is a one-time annual award up to \$500.				
Joe and Chip Rogers ADN Scholarship	This scholarship is awarded annually to a student in the Associate Degree Nursing Program. Must show financial need and a 3.0 GPA.				
Aviation Maintenance Scholarship	The scholarship is awarded to a student enrolled in the Aviation Maintenance Technology Program. Must have demonstrated financial need and a minimum of a 3.0 GPA. Funds may be used for tuition, fees, books, and supplies.				
CoCo Wine Festival Culinary Arts & Crafts	This scholarship is awarded annually. The scholarship is opened to any student enrolled in the Culinary Arts Program. Funds can be used for tuition, fees, books and supplies. Must have a 3.0 GPA, a completed FAFSA on file with the Financial Aid Office, and demonstrate need.				
Herbert and Alan Lichtenberg Scholarship	Established by the Lichtenberg Family in honor of their father and uncle. This scholarship is awarded annually to a student pursuing an Associate Degree and who has demonstrated financial need. The award varies depending on individual needs.				
Ray Powell Memorial Scholarship	Named in honor of former instructor and Vice President for Instruction, Ray Powell. One scholarship is awarded annually for tuition, fees, and books. Each award is up to \$300 per term.				
Jack B. Patrick Scholarship	Established in honor of Jack B. Patrick, former President of Augusta Technical College. Three scholarships are awarded annually for tuition, fees, and books. Each award is up to \$500 per term.				
Richard Edenfield Scholarship	Must be enrolled in the Electrical Construction Maintenance Program. Preference is given to students who are veterans of the Armed Services. Must have a 3.0 GPA. Must have demonstrated financial need. Can be used for tuition, fees, and books.				
Gwinn Huxley Nixon	This scholarship is awarded annually to an Associate Degree level student in any major that demonstrates financial need. Funds can be used for tuition, fees, books or uniforms. Student must be enrolled at least part-time (6-8 credit hours).				
Kyle B. Davis HVAC Scholarship	This scholarship is awarded annually to a HVAC student that demonstrates financial need. Funds can be used for tuition, fees, and books. Student must be enrolled at least part-time (6-8 credit hours).				
ADP Accounting Scholarship	This scholarship is awarded to an associate degree level accounting student. Must have demonstrated need and a minimum of a 3.0 GPA. Funds may be used for tuition, fees, books, or supplies.
